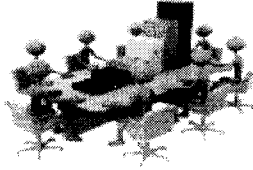

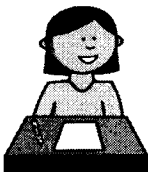

The Association feels it is essential to participate in these learning opportunities to learn best practices and ethics, earn educational credits and to stay abreast of legislation that is relevant to our offices and job functions.

Educational opportunities will be available in numerous ways and in various locations throughout the state. See outline below for some of the educational opportunities and how each will play a role in the overall educational plan for our members. It is the intent of the Association to plan the educational programs in advance to allow every opportunity to provide the most beneficial educational experience possible. However it is the responsibility of each Register of Deeds to participate as fully as possible in this continual learning program.

Register of Deeds Educational Training

After the election cycle for Register of Deeds every four years, the Association will sponsor a school for new Register of Deeds although the school is focused on the education of newly elected Registers we encourage all officials and staff to attend, certification education hours are available. By attending this school you shall receive valuable educational manuals that include the curriculum and reference materials.

Register of Deeds Annual Seminar

The Annual Seminar also referred to in the By Laws as the Semi-Annual meeting is held each year in the late spring or early summer months, depending on hotel scheduling. This meeting usually consists of approximately 3 to 4 days out of the office depending on travel time. This meeting is scheduled from year to year at difference locations around the state. This is a meeting of Register of Deeds and consists of workshops taught by outside speakers as well as by members within our own association. The

selection of the subject matter and discussion groups is determined by the Register of Deeds Executive Board in conjunction with the host and education committee. There will be in-depth presentations and pertinent to Register of Deeds information offered at this seminar. The Annual seminar is a great opportunity for meeting other Registers of Deeds and having the opportunity to network and exchange information and ideas with your peers across the state.

Register of Deeds District Meetings

These meetings serve as an opportunity to network and learn from other register's experiences. Everyone is encouraged to bring forward problems and get assistance from their peers in possible solutions. District Secretaries will be encouraged to share the information by submitting minutes to the Register of Deeds Registrar which is the Association's publication printed in conjunction with the annual and semi-annual meetings.

Kansas Association of Counties (KAC) Annual Meeting

This meeting is held each November and the location rotates between the three largest cities in the state. Kansas Counties that are members of KAC pay yearly dues. If your county is a member you may attend the KAC conference. Membership to KAC changed in 2004 when at the time Kansas County Clerks, Sheriffs, Treasurers and Register of Deeds Associations voted to leave KAC.

Kansas Association of Counties (KAC) Training

These certification programs will be used to enhance the general knowledge of KAC's membership.

Kansas County Officials Association (KCOA) As of Dec. 31, 2016 No longer is an association

KCOA is committed to upholding democratic principles, which allow Kansans to determine their constitutional right of self-governance including the election of local officials. The KCOA is made up of two affiliate association, including the Kansas Register of Deeds Association and Kansas County Treasurer's Association. The annual conference which is held in September is open to anyone who wants to register. The past several years have included educational portions which Registers may attend and receive credit for continuing education and certification.

Kansas Register of Deeds Certification Program

The Kansas Register of Deeds Association works hand in hand with the Kansas State University Division of Continuing Education Department to offer a complete learning experience. Classes will be taught by university approved instructors who shall present learning material and experiences that are relevant to the Register of Deeds Office. Register of Deeds Certification and Re-Certifications are available through this program. There is a Register of Deeds/CES Self-Report Form available to obtain credits for other courses of study taken.

Welcome

Welcome to the Kansas Register of Deeds Association home page. In Kansas, almost all of the 105 counties elect a Register of Deeds every four years. The Register of Deeds offices maintain and preserve the land records of the county. Deeds, mortgages, easements, oil and gas leases, and plats are documents typically filed in the Register of Deeds office. The filing fees and required indexes are set by state statute. Recording methods vary throughout the state. Some counties make only "paper" copies as the permanent record, other counties microfilm, and some "image". Often, a combination of these methods is utilized. Some counties have computer-generated databases and others keep hand or typewritten indexes. All rely on extensive cross-indexing methods so documents are easy to find.

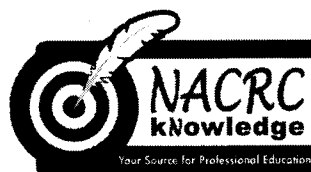
